Available Training Courses:

• Nurse Aide (C.N.A.)

65 hours of classroom/lab instruction and 60 hours of hands-on clinical experience at a local healthcare facility.

Application Requirements:

To apply for the CNA course, all students are required to complete:

- Criminal Background Check
- Child Abuse Clearance
- 2-Step TB Test
- Physical

All is at the cost of the student

Students must also supply a copy of their high school diploma or GED.
