A free career pathway program for those looking to land a good job with benefits.

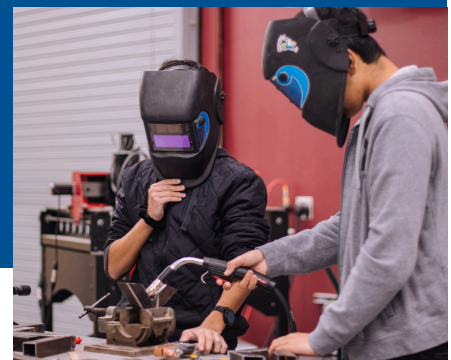
The program includes:
