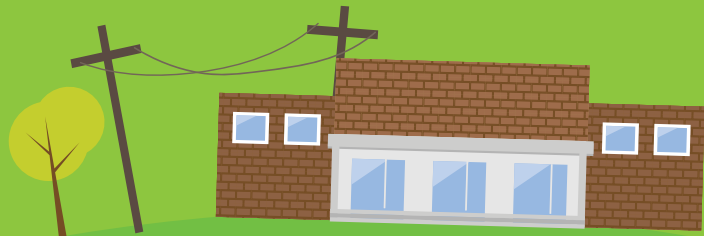

STEPPING FORWARD WORKS

62 candidates enrolled in the program...

11% were veterans. 56% had a criminal background. 100% have an identified barrier or pattern of behavior that impacted their ability to maintain employment.

12 Industry Partners and 10 Volunteer Professionals work with students during the 6 week program.

75% of candidates completed coursework and achieved an industry recognized certification.

83% of candidates remained employed a year after completion of the Stepping Forward Works program.
